GIGABYTE Biodiversity and No Deforestation Commitment

GIGABYTE has been committed to advancing environmental sustainability. In addition to focusing on climate change, the Company continuously explores diverse approaches to nature conservation. GIGABYTE's global operations are not located in areas designated as having high biodiversity value. Nevertheless, the Company is committed to conducting environmental impact assessments in accordance with local environmental regulations within its operational boundaries, to avoid adverse impacts on biodiversity. GIGABYTE is also dedicated to developing and implementing biodiversity conservation practices at both local and group levels.

In response to the 2050 vision of "Living in Harmony with Nature" and the global goal of achieving zero deforestation, no net loss of nature, and net positive impact, GIGABYTE has established this commitment as a guiding framework and will engage in collaboration with stakeholders to co-create sustainable value.

I. Scope of Application

This policy applies to GIGABYTE Group and all its domestic and international subsidiaries.

II. Strategy Guidelines

- Commit to the conservation of biodiversity, ensuring compliance with international, national, and local biodiversity-related regulations.
- Avoid or minimize operations near areas of high biodiversity value; conduct biodiversity risk
 assessments across operational sites, product design and development, and raw material
 procurement. Implement mitigation measures to avoid, minimize, restore, and offset
 biodiversity impacts.
- Mitigate the company's contribution to climate change and implement climate-related management and adaptation measures to prevent biodiversity loss caused by climate change.
- Promote the use of deforestation-free materials across operations and progressively scale up their adoption to support global deforestation mitigation efforts.
- Avoid or minimize the impact of value chain activities on biodiversity and ecosystem services.
- Encourage suppliers and partners to assess biodiversity risks at their operational sites and establish their own biodiversity commitments.
- Implement biodiversity education initiatives for stakeholders—including employees, customers, and suppliers—through training and nature-related projects to strengthen ecological awareness.
- Collaborate with non-profit organizations to support forest and biodiversity conservation initiatives.
- This policy shall become effective upon endorsement and signature by the Chairman. Any revisions shall be processed in accordance with the same approval procedure.
